Youth for Troops: Inspiring Patriotism Across Generations
Youth for Troops (YFT) is a youth-led, service-focused nonprofit
organization with a mission to inspire this generation—and all
generations—to volunteer together and support service
members and veterans. YFT strives to build respect and
appreciation for those who protect our liberties and freedoms
through meaningful experiences and unique volunteer
opportunities.

Their mission is: "To inspire patriotism in fellow youth and across generations by volunteering on behalf of service members and veterans through community service, advocacy, and education."

YFT was founded in 2017 by six youth board members who saw that most service opportunities were geared toward adults. They created an organization where people of all ages—from 0 to 120—could volunteer. Today, their vision has grown into a successful movement that offers free, family-friendly service events supporting veterans and service members.

# Youth For Troops Programs & Accomplishments

- Sending Care Packages
- Raised \$266.205 to cover shipping costs
- Plastic Mats for Homeless Veterans
- Care Bags & Supplies for Veterans
- Provide Flag lines for active-duty homecomings, military funerals & other veteran events
- This holiday season, YFT is raising over \$18,000 to ship 1,200 care packages. Their R.E.D. Ornament campaign allows supporters to purchase a \$5 ornament and write a message to be sent in a holiday package to a deployed hero. Ornaments can also be kept at home as a reminder to Remember Everyone Deployed.
